Loans Available

Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan - \$20,500

6.08% interest accrues throughout the life of the loan, and 1.059% origination fee; 6-month grace period after graduation

Direct Graduate PLUS Loan - up to cost of attendance, minus any other awards or scholarships 7.08% interest accrues throughout the life of the loan and 4.236% origination fee; repayment begins 6 months after graduation

Private or Alternative Loan – Through the lender of your choice; may borrow up to cost of attendance, minus any other awards or scholarships. Repayment and interest terms are agreed upon between you and the lender.

- Must work a certain number of hours as arranged by you and PT Program
- Must maintain a 3.25 cumulative GPA and good evaluations to renew award
- Awarded by PT Program
- **To Apply**: Complete application provided in Admittance Packet

Federal Work-Study

- Job within PT Program
- Funds earned through bi-weekly paycheck
- Hourly rate of pay determined by PT Program
- Work-study earnings count toward your Cost of Attendance
- Awardees determined in August/September
- Placed by PT program after eligibility is determined by Financial Aid
