PT Clinical Performance Instrument (PT CPI)

- The PT Clinical Performance Instrument (CPT) is used for grading all of the clinical experiences.
- All Clinical Coordinators of Clinical Education (CCCEs) and Clinical Instructors (CIs) must complete on-line training for the use of the PT CPI Web grading tool.
- Each individual is required to complete the on-line training *only once*.
- The training program takes about 1.5 hours to complete.
- A CEU certificate is awarded upon completion of the training.
- *The on-line training MUST be completed BEFORE you can access your student's CPI.*

Address of Site

User Name

To log in, use the e-mail address that you or your CCCE provided as your User Name.

Password

If you *previously have logged into* PT CPI Web version 1.0, your password will be the *same* for PT CPI Web version 2.0.

If you have *never logged into* PT CPI Web **OR** if you want to *reset your password*, please do the following:

3. Enter your **User Name (e-mail address)** in the text box.
